### THINGS HOT UP AT THE HOT WALL

On Friday 29th June Volunteers and Friends learnt how to train the fruit trees in summer. from Robert Boyle of Carrob Growers who supplied the espalier trees for the Hot Wall. He tied the branches onto canes to train them before they are tied on the wires in Autumn. He showed us how to shorten the branches to encourage future fruit spurs. He also said it was important to mulch each tree now to keep moisture around the roots.
